

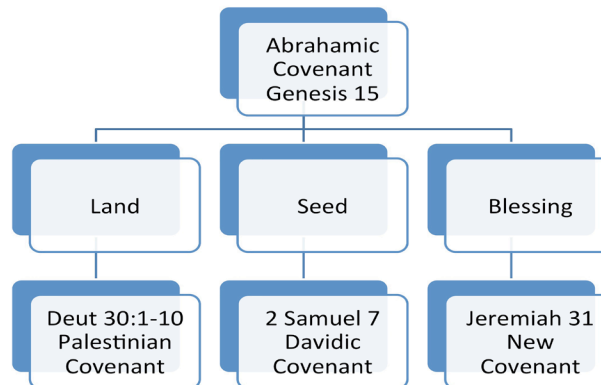

The Davidic Covenant

- Its main features (2 Sam 7:16)
 - A "house": David's physical descendants
 - A "kingdom": the geo-political entity he'd rule
 - A "throne": the authority as king vested in him
- Its characteristics
 - Unilateral (one way; from God to David)
 - Unending (2 Sam 7:13, 16; Ps 89:3-4)
 - Unconditional (it relies on God for its fulfillment)
 - Literal (it takes place on the earth in Jerusalem)

Tracing The Davidic Covenant: OT

- David's house (his descendants)
 - David's line continued (see Matt 1:1, 12-17)
- David's kingdom (the geo-political entity)
 - Ended for a time in 586 BC with Nebuchadnezzar
 - "Times of the Gentiles" began (see Luke 21:24)
- David's throne (his right to rule)
 - Isa 11:1-5; Jer 33:14-22; Micah 5:2; Amos 9:1-15
 - Hosea 3:5; Ezek 37:24-27; Zech 9:9
 - It's actively anticipated to this day

Tracing The Davidic Covenant: NT

- David's house (his descendants)
 - Matthew 1; Luke 3
- David's house, kingdom and throne
 - Luke 1:32-33; Matt 12:23; 26:63-64; Romans 1:3
- The greater Son of David's living temple
 - 1 Corinthians 3:16

Jesus has been anointed King, but like David is waiting on God's timing to take His throne
Timing of the coming kingdom and throne
The subject of Daniel and Revelation
Implications of this biblical, literal fulfillment
Israel must be preserved as a nation
Israel must be brought back into the land of her inheritance
Jesus must return to the earth bodily and literally
A literal earthly kingdom must exist for Him
His kingdom will become an eternal kingdom

Importance Of The Davidic Covenant

There is a Church today ...

Because of God's faithfulness to His promise to David, bringing Jesus Christ, the **Messiah** and Savior, through his "house," his family tree (e.g. Isaiah 11:1-5)

There is a future for Israel ...

Because of God's faithfulness to His promises to David to one day establish a literal, eternal house, kingdom and throne upon the earth

An Unmet Desire (2 Sam 7)

David's desire (7:1-3)

To build a temple for Israel's true King

God's answer (7:4-17)

"No. Your son will build a temple for me."

"But ... I will build you a house, a royal dynasty."

David's response to God's "no" (7:18-29)

He praised God for His character

He praised God for His past goodness and kindness to His people and to him

Application: God has a better "yes" in mind whenever He says "no"

When God Has Told Me "No"

In my life ...

I sought a Master's degree from Purdue ...

Wanting my plan to work for going to seminary ...

Not wanting to be in Children's Ministry ...

Wanting to go back to Sacramento to plant a church ...

Coming to Christ Chapel ...

And I wouldn't want it any other way!

What has God said "no" about to you?

When God Says "No" To You

Focus on His character instead of your "loss"

He is good and kind

He is merciful and gracious

He is wise and omnisciently far-sighted

He knows what He's doing

Focus on His past actions in your life

How He's intervened for good in your life before

Remember that God has a better "yes" in mind for you whenever He says "no"
