Use the following as a starting point for conversation:

1. Read 1 Peter 1:14-16 aloud.
2. What are your thoughts on holiness? Is this a characteristic of God that you've spent much time thinking about before? Is it a characteristic you've meditated on before? Does it lead you to worship God? Why or why not?
3. What do you think it would look like to be set apart in your character? Is your character consistent no matter who you're around? What steps can you take to grow in this area?
4. What do you think it would look like to be set apart in your obedience? Are there things God commands you to do or not do that you've been convicted about not following? What steps will you take to grow in obedience?
5. What do you think it would look like to be set apart in your worship? What are the idols you most struggle with worshipping in the place of God? How are your affections stirred for the Lord? What steps will you take to pursue holiness in your worship of God?
6. As you pursue holiness, what will help you make sure you're not just modifying your behavior but are instead responding to God in heartfelt worship?
