Use the following as a starting point for conversation:

1. Read James 4:13-15 and Romans 12:2 aloud.
2. How do you usually make decisions? When and how does considering God's will come into the picture? How do you typically try to discern His will?
3. Read Proverbs 16:9 aloud.
4. Is it hard for you to believe that the Lord cares about the steps you take? Is it hard for you to trust that His plans for you are good ones? Why do you think that is?
5. Ben said the first step to hearing clearly from God is to know the Word of God. Do you read the Bible regularly? How do you study it? What does your time in Scripture look like? If you feel like you don't read the Bible regularly or know how to study it, how would you like to grow in that? What steps will you take to follow through?
6. As we begin this series on listening to God, is there anything in your life you're specifically hoping to hear His guidance on? Share with your group and spend some time praying that you'll all be sensitive to His leading in these areas over the next few weeks.
