

## **God's Final Word**

Revelation 22:6-21

### **The nature and purpose of the message**

**22:6-11**

- The entire message is the trustworthy, true and urgent message of \_\_\_\_\_.
- The message is generous and intended to bless.
- John is instructed again not to worship the angelic messenger, but to worship God.
- God's purpose is a written message of gracious warning.
- Human beings have two choices: right standing with God or rebellion against God.

### **The core of the message: Jesus is coming back bringing wages and rewards**

**22:12-16**

- The rebellious will receive \_\_\_\_\_ and eternal separation from God as wages for their sin.
- Believers will receive \_\_\_\_\_ for good works at the Judgment Seat of Christ.
- Jesus has all authority to judge and reward as the Alpha and the Omega.
  - As Alpha, He is the beginning, the source of all things working in creation.
  - As Omega, He is the end, reigning after the old heaven and earth are destroyed.
  - He is the summation of God's interaction with humankind.

**Jesus' plan extends the greatest invitation of all times:  
choose blessing and live in the presence of God for eternity.**

### **Responses to the message**

**22:17-19**

- The Holy Spirit and the Church invite the world to Jesus with the word "Come!"
- The one hearing for the first time, believes and turns to the world saying "Come!"
- Those with spiritual needs and those who are willing are invited to come to Jesus.
- Some will distort and pervert God's prophetic words, bringing God's judgment on themselves.

### **Last words**

**22:20-21**

- The entire message is Jesus' testimony that "I am coming soon."
- John's prayerful response is "Amen. Come, Lord Jesus!"
- The message closes with a benediction of \_\_\_\_\_.

**The Big Reveal – Revelation 22:6-21**

**REVELATION 1:3** Blessed is the one who reads aloud the words of this prophecy, and blessed are those who hear, and who keep what is written in it, for the time is near.
