# *For Freedom's Sake*

GALATIANS 5:1-15

**Freedom in Christ IS THE \_\_\_\_\_ OF THE CHRISTIAN LIFE.**

*For freedom Christ has set us free; stand firm therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery. v. 1*

## *The "What and Where" of True Christian Freedom*

**Freedom in Christ is an \_\_\_\_\_ proposition.**

*Look: I, Paul, say to you that if you accept circumcision, Christ will be of no advantage to you. I testify again to every man who accepts circumcision that he is obligated to keep the whole law. You are severed from Christ, you who would be justified by the law; you have fallen away from grace. vv. 2-4*

**Freedom in Christ brings a comforting \_\_\_\_\_.**

*For through the Spirit, by faith, we ourselves eagerly wait for the hope of righteousness. For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision counts for anything, but only faith working through love. vv. 5-6*

**Freedom in Christ will inevitably be attacked by its first enemy: \_\_\_\_\_.**

*You were running well. Who hindered you from obeying the truth? 8 This persuasion is not from him who calls you. A little leaven leavens the whole lump. I have confidence in the Lord that you will take no other view, and the one who is troubling you will bear the penalty, whoever he is. vv. 7-10*

**Freedom in Christ does not mean worldly \_\_\_\_\_.**

*But if I, brothers, still preach circumcision, why am I still being persecuted? In that case the offense of the cross has been removed. I wish those who unsettle you would emasculate themselves! vv. 11-12*

**Freedom in Christ has a second enemy: \_\_\_\_\_.**

*For you were called to freedom, brothers. Only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another. v. 13*

**Freedom in Christ is practiced and perfected by \_\_\_\_\_ others.**

*For the whole law is fulfilled in one word: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." But if you bite and devour one another, watch out that you are not consumed by one another. vv. 14-15*

1. What in this sermon was especially helpful to you?

2. Read Galatians 5:1-15. When we are legalistic, Paul says "you have fallen away from grace" (v. 4). He is not saying we will lose our salvation, but what is he saying we *will* lose? What can we do to make sure that we stay free?

3. Freedom has two enemies: *legalism* and *license*. Explain how drifting into either of these is the opposite of freedom.

*Hold fast the freedom*

"It is best to be watchful and constant, so that you may keep and hold fast the freedom with which Christ has made you free. Those who are complacent and negligent cannot keep this freedom, for Satan has a deadly hatred of the light of the Gospel—that is to say, the doctrine of grace, liberty, consolation, and life. Therefore, once he sees it begin to appear, he fights against it with all his might and force, stirring up storms and tempests to hinder its course and overthrow it. Therefore, Paul warns the believers not to sleep, not to be negligent, but constantly and valiantly to resist Satan, so that he does not spoil them of the freedom that Christ has purchased for them."

5. Read 1 Peter 2:16. Instead of supporting our freedom, how does indulging in our sinful nature take it away?

6. Paul tells us, "do not use your freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another." What does it look like, practically speaking, to serve others with our freedom?
