**BIBLICAL REASONS WHY

1. God is the creator of life and creates people in His image. *(Gen 1:26-27)*

3. God's law established severe punishment for those who don't protect life, including the unborn. *(Gen 9:6; Ex 21:22-23)*
4. Jesus values a human soul greater than other aspects of His creation. *(Matt 6:26; Mk 8:36)*
5. Jesus says He came to give people an abundant life. *(Jn 10:10)*
