PARKING ADVISORY With utility construction beginning for the Link building, our regular parking patterns are changing. Please make note of the following ways to access parking during construction. First: Consider the safe and convenient remote parking lot located on Montgomery Street, next to the large white building, where a shuttle bus picks up and drops off at the east main entrance to the church, and returns you to the lot after services; shuttles run 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. each Sunday. Second: If you approach CCBC from the west, exit Montgomery Street, cross the bridge north, turn immediately west on the access road, and follow the signs to the parking garage. As a reminder, please follow directives from Fort Worth Police and our Volunteer Parking Ministry as they facilitate the flow of traffic – your cooperation with and respect for them is appreciated!
