
Despite the fact that God has made us new in Christ ...

HOME GROUP LESSON

1. How do your old nature (under point I. of the sermon) or the three powerful influences (under point II.) made your walk with Christ messy? In other words, how has your old life called to you, trying to keep you close to the wall instead of moving toward Jesus?

2. To *set our mind* (Rom 8:5) refers to interests that occupy us, how we spend our time/money/energy, or what we give ourselves up to. Why do we believe the lie that we can "rent a room next to a life of sin" and tame our flesh so it obeys us? What's wrong with this kind of thinking?

3. Romans 8:1 says *there is no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus*. How have you mistaken the consequences of sin for God's condemnation? Why is it so hard for us to live as if we believe that in Christ there is no condemnation?

4. Romans chapter 7 is a cry of despair over how our corrupt flesh longs for deliverance, but chapter 8 is a cry of triumph because of Jesus Christ, the one and only Deliverer. How has studying these chapters caused you to praise Jesus for what He has done for you? How has it made a difference in your daily life?

5. How have you as a Christian experienced the indwelling Holy Spirit as the only way to overcome the desires of your flesh? Encourage others in your group by sharing your experience.

"The distinguishing characteristic of the Christian, which sets him apart from all unbelievers, is that the Holy Spirit dwells in him. ... Indwelling sin is the lot of all the children of Adam; the great privilege of the children of God is to have the indwelling Spirit to fight and subdue indwelling sin." —John R. L. Stott

6. here are you so weary that you want to give up the struggle against sin? How much of that struggle has depended on your own efforts? How has this sermon given you a fresh dependence on the Holy Spirit?

Close in prayer. Ask God for His help to live what you learned in the sermon.
