IS GOD'S WORD YOUR "GO-TO" _____ IN LIFE?

"All flesh is like grass and all its glory like the flower of grass. The grass withers, and the flower falls, but the word of the Lord remains forever." And this word is the good news that was preached to you. 1 Peter 1:24-25

... so that we may no longer be children, tossed to and fro by the waves and carried about by every wind of doctrine, by human cunning, by craftiness in deceitful schemes. Rather, speaking the *truth in love*, we are to grow up in every way into him who is the head, into Christ ...

Ephesians 4:14-15

1. Think of the most spiritually mature person you know. What specific characteristics mark them as mature in their relationships?

2. Read 1 Peter 1:22–2:3. What other sources besides the Word of God do you allow hourly, daily or weekly to speak into your life? (Examples: electronic and print news, social media platforms, friends, music, streaming channels, apps, blogs, movies, radio, podcasts.)

3. Read Ephesians 4:14-15. How do the things listed in this passage keep us from maturing? How do we know when we've had too little of God's Word and too much input from "human cunning" and "craftiness"?

4. How do you see malice, deceit, hypocrisy, envy and slander (1 Pet 2:1) going on around us every day? In what ways might those have seeped undetected into your own interactions, eroding relationships and causing division?

5. What does it look like to "love one another earnestly" (1 Pet 1:22)?

6. Besides the 22-Day Challenge from the sermon (see box above), see how many days you are able to "fast" from all other sources you listed in question 2 while you only engage with the Word of God.

What would it look like if you regularly implemented such a fasting practice from everything except the "pure milk" of the Bible?
