Then Pilate said to him, "So you are a king?" Jesus answered, "You say that I am a king. For this purpose I was born and for this purpose I have come into the world—to bear witness to the truth. Everyone who is of the truth listens to my voice." v. 37

5. Read Hebrews 2:5-9. How have you seen God at work in the world lately? What about these "already but not yet" aspects of Jesus' kingdom rule encourages you?

6. Read Hebrews 12:1-3. How does this passage bring an eternal perspective to the things that have been happening this year? How will you keep the view of Jesus from this lesson in the forefront of your thoughts going forward?
