5. Which of the sermon points do you most need to apply to your circumstances this coming week? Why? What plans can you make to apply them?

6. Spend some time reading and meditating on the Scriptures listed above, paying close attention to ones that speak directly to your specific concerns right now. Make any notes here about what is causing you unrest, and how God's Word is helping you to rest instead.
