

## OPEN MY EYES!

PSALM 119:1-24

Open my eyes to the \_\_\_\_\_ of Psalm 119.

- The author is unknown.
- It is written as an acrostic with the 22 letters of the Hebrew alphabet.
- It contains a reference to God's Word in 171 of 176 verses, using 10 synonyms for His Word.
- The theme is the value, use, and practical application of God's Word in our lives.

*Pray for a deep love and hunger for God's Word.*

Open my eyes to the blessings of \_\_\_\_\_ to God's Word. Vs. 1-8

- Blessings come to those who obey God's Word as they seek Him with their whole hearts.
- Recognizing the blessings of obedience leads us to desire greater obedience in life.
- Fixing our eyes on God's commands and walking diligently in His truth keeps us from harm.
- A deeper understanding of God's Word leads to praise and adoration of God Himself.

*Pray for a heart of obedience to God's Word.*

Open my eyes to the \_\_\_\_\_ that comes from living out God's Word. Vs. 9-16

- The path to a pure life is paved with the truth of God's Word.
- Internalizing God's Word leads to understanding and truth that protects our hearts from sin.
- A teachable heart calls out to God for His instruction in His Word.
- Meditating and gazing intently on God's Precepts will bring delight and understanding.

*Pray for a pure heart that comes from keeping God's Word constantly before you.*

Open my eyes to the \_\_\_\_\_ of God's Word. Vs. 17-24

- God can illuminate hearts and minds to wonderful truths in His Word.
- The psalmist expresses a huge appetite for God's Word.
- Those who love the scriptures and live by them will be persecuted and oppressed by those who do not.
- God's Word gives wise counsel during the hardest of times.

*Pray for understanding of His Word which will bring wisdom and truth in all circumstances.*
