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HOME GROUP DISCUSSION

1. During what times in your life have you realized you needed to come back to God? What caused the realization?

2. Read Nehemiah chapter 9. On the sermon notes under point II is a table listing Israel's waywardness in this chapter. What difference is there between what Israel's ancestors did, what Nehemiah's people were doing, and what we do now? Why is that important?

3. The table also lists God's faithfulness. During your own cycles of disobedience, what memories do you have of God's care even during those times?

4. No matter what sin we are caught up in, there is always a way back because of the phrase "BUT GOD." List all these "BUT GOD" responses to Israel's sins in this chapter. How does each show God's character?

5. How do those "BUT GOD" responses apply to your own situation? How does that change your outlook?

6. Someone has said that *in confession we discover a greater freedom to tell the truth about ourselves*. Take some time alone to pray over and fill out the HEARTWORK section of the sermon notes this week. Tell the truth about yourself. What do you need to confess and repent of?
